Population figures are believed to be up to between double and three times the 2001 census figures. ***This should be borne in mind during the scrutiny process***

Stop Search data

Highlight this Quarter

It was reported that the force wide total number of stop searches and the number of white stop searches have decreased whilst BME stop and searches have increased

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

It was confirmed that there are no particular trends to note.

Stop & search leading to arrest

Highlight this Quarter

It was noted that both the number of white and BME arrests have decreased this quarter.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

D Division to examine the stop searches made by the Division compared to the nil arrest rate and report back.

Disposal methods for detainees

Generally there has been a decrease in all disposal methods, however the percentages are largely similar to those of the last quarter.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

Force wide the number of crimes recorded, detected and detection rates have all fallen this quarter.

C Division to examine the 12 crimes recorded this quarter and determine the reason as to why only 4 were detected.
